


Figure 4: TBCSD Project Summary in 2023 - Framework of Project and Activity






Figure 7 - 8: TBCSD Project Summary in 2023 - Other activities to support sustainable development

5. ISSUES FOR CONSIDERATION

5.1 2024 Work Plan

Motion: To present the 2024 Work Plan of TBCSD.

<u>Resolved:</u> Motion carried and message acknowledged. The meeting agreed that the TBCSD Work Plan in 2024 can be proceeded as proposed.

• Implementation Framework




Figure 10: 2024 Implementation Framework of Project/Program

In 2024, TBCSD will continue addressing country s environment and sustainable development issues according to the TBCSD Implementation Framework illustrated in Figure 10. The Fundamental Project/Program will focus on strengthening business foundation in 3 priority areas; economy, environment, and society. For Collective Project/Program, TBCSD will contribute its efforts to the tackle 3 key issues such as Country environmental issues, Low Carbon and Sustainable Business and Environment Social Governance (ESG). In addition, TBCSD will continue its support on the 3 area-based projects namely Sustainable Consumption and Production, Business for Biodiversity and Electronic Waste. In addition, TBCSD will continue to scale up the actions by sharing good practices.

Comments and Suggestions from the participants.

- The meeting agreed to organize a meeting among TBCSD members to conclude the outcomes from COP28, the way forward and analyze the impacts/opportunities for Thailand. This meeting among TBCSD members is expected to propose guidelines for driving the Thai business sector towards a low- carbon and sustainability for each industry. Recommendations on the measures to support the solutions to the climate change problem from the private sector's perspectives will also be made to the government. This will demonstrate our commitment to help drive the country towards a low-carbon and sustainability.
- The meeting agreed that TBCSD should organize an event to share knowledge and exchange experience among TBCSD members in sustainable development. The objective is to develop capacity of TBCSD members to understand and be able to apply the knowledge and experience gained from the event to their own context.
- The meeting agreed to have a joint activities or projects among TBCSD members to drive the climate change mitigation, especially capacity development among TBCSD members in the aspect of climate change. The members are expected to understand their greenhouse gas emission status and mitigation potential. The data collected will be use as a database for future operational planning. This activity will allow TBCSD members to realize their potential contribution to the national greenhouse gas reduction target, based on each industry's context.

• The meeting agreed to extend the cooperation framework between TBCSD members and the public sector in the Thai private sector s sustainable development for solving the country s issue and national sustainable development. This cooperation will elevate the Thai private sector s standard to become low-carbon and sustainable businesses. The framework will also contribute to the environmentally friendly society and economy towards a net-zero greenhouse gas emission, according to national targets and sustainable development goals.

5.2 Budget Management

Motion: To present the Budget Management Plan.

<u>Resolved:</u> Motion carried and message acknowledged. The meeting agreed that the Budget Management should be proceeded as proposed.

Overall available budget for supporting 2024 TBCSD activities is 12,819,191 baht comprising of

- 1) Administration and regular activity
 - Membership fee (10.75 million baht)
- 2) 2022 remaining budget 2,079,191 baht (as of October 2023)
- 3) New project/program/initiative
 - Additional budget with approval by members

In 2024, TBCSD will accelerate the collaboration among the 5 key collaborative partners which are the leading national associations on sustainable development, namely 1) The Federation of Thai Industries, 2) The Thai Chamber of Commerce and Board of Trade of Thailand, 3) The Securities and Exchange Commission, Thailand, 4) The Stock Exchange of Thailand and 5) Thailand Greenhouse Gas Management Organization (Public Organization). The collaborative efforts will prioritize on driving transition toward sustainable business and the low-carbon society, while supporting various national agendas on sustainable development.
