


EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

CEOs from the member organizations

Charter: Executive Committee

- The Executive Committee Members shall hold office for a period of two (2) calendar years.
- The Chairman of the Executive Committee (hereinafter called the "Chairman") is appointed by and amongst the members of the Executive Committee He/She is appointed for 2 years and eligible for re-appointment and can serve up to maximum of 2 consecutive terms.
- The Executive Committee puts forward their recommendation to the Council for approval.
- 6 months before the end of the current term, the Chairman shall invite each of the Association's Group to nominate the Executive Committee.






B&B CHECK: BUSINESS & BIODIVERSITY CHECK








Thai Green Label

is Type 1 environmental label which indicating overall environmental preferability of a product within a particular product category based on life cycle considerations.

Thailand Environment Institute certified Thai Green Label based on ISO/IEC17065 and ISO14024.

Enhancing of type 1 ecolabel product/service certification by GEN mutual recognition.



Why Green Labeled products and services?



"Label that represents the responsible consumption and production"



Products shall get certified or pass the product's quality test according to TIS, ISO, or other national/international standards



Control of hazardous substances used or impurities in raw materials such as heavy metals and carcinogens.



with resources efficiency criteria since raw materials selection to waste management.



Control of GHG emission through the production and product use phase.








